#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

80 degree weather to start October!! Isn't it great? Of course in a couple of months we will be wishing for these days to return!

I am pleased to announce that we have 97% compliance in dues collections. The other 3% have had judgments placed against them with additional legal action to follow. I cannot stress enough the importance of paying your dues. We can no longer tolerate any non-payment of association dues. They are less than \$200.00 per year, yet you get so much in return.....two parks that include tennis, basketball and volleyball courts, baseball fields and playgrounds; a swimming pond with picnic area; and a fishing and boating lake. Please do your share in ensuring that we can continue to enjoy these valuable assets.

The Association is responsible for the maintenance of the dam area. The homeowners whose property includes the dam/berm must keep this area clean and the creek free from obstruction. Those homeowners whose area requires clean-up will be given seven days to bring the area into compliance, then the Association will have it cleaned and bill the homeowner for the work. All outstanding balances are subject to an interest charge of 11/2 % per month.

FYI: The Association does not redeposit NSF checks. If your check is returned for NSF, it will be turned over to our attorney for collections.

Leaf season is here along with the rains. It is important to keep the street gutter drains flowing freely to avoid flooding. You can help by keeping the drains in front of your homes free of these leaves. Thank you for your cooperation.

Streetlights: Our application for the streetlights was delayed due to a personnel change in the city Planning Department. Our alderman, Carl Wasco, assures me that the application is now at ComEd. The installation of the streetlights is expected in the spring.

Nominations are being accepted for the 2008 SLE Board of Directors. If you feel the urge to serve, please fill out and submit the attached form no later than December 15, 2007.

As the holidays approach, please remember those who have no voice and support your local animal shelter. I know I do.

As a personal note, I want to thank the residents of our association for your support and ideas this past year. Here's hoping 2008 will be as good as 2007.

#### NEW LUMINARY FUN!

Sunday, December 16th, 4:30 p.m., together we light our luminary, dim our entry lights, and warm our neighborhood hearts again. This lovely annual

event brightens winter days ahead with awesome neighborhood memories. Plan your display now and collect your supplies early! For a traditional display, here's what you'll need:

- 1. White, weather resistant luminary bags; use approximately 1 per every 2 feet of your path.
- 2. White luminary candles; use 1 per bag.
- 3. Sand or kitty litter; approximately 2 cups per bag.
- 4. Long lighter; like the one to start grills.

These supplies can be found at Zanocco Ace Hardware at 1605 N. Alpine in the Edgebrook Shopping Center. (Also available elsewhere.)

To assemble the luminaries:

- 1. fold bag tops down about 2" to anchor the bag shape
- 2. put 2 cups of sand or kitty litter in each bag
- after placing your luminary bags along your drive or pathway, securely mount a candle in the center of the sand within the bags. (Take care that the area is free of any debris or obstruction.)


Instead of candles, battery operated lights of various sizes are available. Metal luminary "bags" are also available. Or go creative with milk cartons, jars or ice!

The luminaries will be lit at 4:30 p.m. on Sunday, December 16<sup>th</sup> for that evening only. Grab your camera, walk the neighborhood, greet your neighbors, or plan a party for that day. Enjoy the beauty of the season!

Collect your luminary remains the next day. Reuse, recycle or share what you can.

The moral of the story.....keep your purse and other valuables out of sight and away from windows!!!





Benjamin was born August 15th to Ted and Khamby Scordato. That's 4 little boys born in our neighborhood in just over a year's time.


